

- DON'T DEFINE SUCCESS AND FAILURE IN TERMS OF WINNING AND LOSING
- BE SUPPORTIVE, DON'T COACH
- HELP MAKE THE SPORT FUN FOR YOUR CHILD
- WHOSE GOAL IS IT? IT'S YOUR CHILD'S SPORT
- YOUR CHILD IS NOT THEIR PERFORMANCE
   LOVE THEM UNCONDITIONALLY
- REMEMBER THE IMPORTANCE OF BUILDING SELF-ESTEEM IN ALL OF YOUR INTERACTIONS
- TEACH YOUR CHILD THE GIFT OF FAILURE


